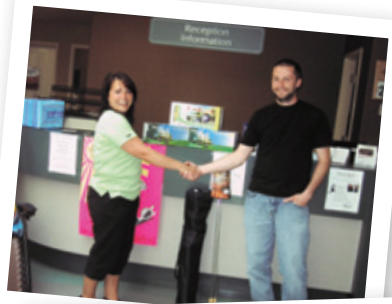
## COMMUNITY SUPPORT
